B 7: BOARD ELECTION PROCEDURE

In the event that there are three or more candidates for an office and no candidate receives a majority through three ballots, the name of the candidate with the least number of votes on the third ballot shall be withdrawn from nomination. Thereafter, balloting shall continue with a similar reduction of the number of candidates on each successive ballot until a candidate receives a majority vote. In the event that two or more candidates have an equal number of votes, which are the least of the candidates' vote totals, the names of the candidates with the equal lowest vote totals shall be withdrawn from nomination in accordance with the above procedure. In no case, however, shall the withdrawal of two or more nominations as a result of their equal lowest vote totals, result in only one candidate standing for election.
