G 20: HAZARDOUS CLASSROOM MATERIALS

Former Policy JHF

Principals and Program Directors will supervise the purchase and use of all materials which are used in the classroom or laboratory. Under normal circumstances, the use of any toxic or potentially hazardous materials is prohibited. In instances where the use of a potentially toxic or hazardous materials is critical to the instructional program, approved safety precautions, i.e. OSHA/VOSHA Workplace regulations, will be implemented by the teacher or laboratory supervisor. Such precautions will include appropriate procedures for preparation, class use and disposal of such materials. In all cases the classroom instructor will check the proper M.S.D.S. (Materials Safety Data Sheet) prior to the use of potentially hazardous materials in a demonstration or experiment.
