- ENTRY FEE:** HS athletes \$30.00 PER COMPETITOR FEE

- ENTRIES:** **Web Entry – Athletic.net ONLY** - no Hy-Tek files please - **by Thursday, June 1st, 2017**
Athletes will be seeded into 1st day events based on Decathlon points from previous years.
Please enter your athletes into Decathlon (event) and enter performance points for athletes with a prior decathlon experience.
- ELIGIBILITY:** HS - maximum of six (6) boys and six (6) girls from each school may compete.
College athletes will compete in the OPEN DIVISION.
- APPROVED:** by Vermont Principals Association.
- USATF:** Vermont Decathlon Championship is USATF sanctioned event.
- SHOES:** All weather track and runways (3/16" spikes max.); Cement circles (Flats). **Javelin has a synthetic runway (spikes 3/16" max.)!!!**
- AWARDS:** HS - Individual awards will be given to the first 15 places in each event. In addition, again this year, awards will be given to the HIGHEST team place total - 3 athletes per team in a team competition. All awards will be given out at the track, following the events for all competitors and accompanying coaches on the 2nd day.
- REGISTRATION:** Will be open 9:00-9:30 AM. Please make sure you weigh-in your implements and present the Pole Vault Certification form with correctly marked poles. **ALL ATHLETES MUST CHECK IN NO LATER THAN 9:30 AM.**
- EVENTS:** Athletes unable to compete in PV competition must attempt a jump to receive NH mark. We will use 2 pits for HJ and PV competition. Weights of implements and heights of hurdles will be according to NFHS/IAAF rules.

DECATHLON SCORING: IAAF FAT Scoring Tables (Hy-Tek Scoring System)

TEAM COMPETITION: Team score in both genders will be determined by totaling the best 3 places scored by the top 3 overall finishers of the each team. (1st place = 100 pts, 2nd place = 99 points etc.)

MEET DIRECTOR: Pavel Dvorak, Burlington HS, Burlington, VT

RULES: NFHS/IAAF rules will be followed.

PARKING: UVM - must pay for parking if parked in a pay location

ENTRY FEE MUST BE POSTMARKED BY JUNE 1st, 2016

MISC.:

- Every High School or an individual HS athlete must be accompanied by a coach or an adult.
- **All coaches and/or adults accompanying HS competitors will be asked to help with field events officiating. Attendance will be taken during the coaches meeting. Your cooperation is needed and appreciated.**
- *In field events athletes may provide their own markers. The host school will provide ½ tennis balls. Markers must be placed outside of runways. There is a maximum limit of 2 markers per competitor. **No tape is allowed.** Chalk is OK.*
- **Implement weigh-in / pole vault:** Implement weigh-in will be open 9:00 – 9:45 AM. Pole vaults will be inspected at the pole vault sector. Only inspected and marked equipment will be permitted in competition and in warm-up throws.
- **Pole Vault Weight Certification Form:** Every coach of an athlete competing in PV must submit the Weight Certification Form to the PV official at least 60 min prior to the start of the competition.
- **School - please bring your first aid kits and ice/plastic bags.**
- **No pets allowed on UVM athletic facility**

NOTES: The Boys Decathlon will be run concurrently with the Girls Decathlon on both days.

THERE WILL BE NO POST ENTRIES. ALSO, THERE WILL BE NO OVERNIGHT CAMPING IN THE FACILITY BY ANY OF THE CONTESTANTS AND/OR HOSTS.
