Entries:

All participating schools (listed below) will enter using Athletic.net website.

Athletic.net website (free of charge for all teams) **No Hy-Tek TM or MS excel files please!**

It may take up to 48 hours to establish new account on Athletic.net web. Athlete's grade must be listed.

High School – Team Entries – please enter all your participating runners into 5000 m Run - you will be charged per entered runner (see below). Athletes on your team roster not entered into the event will not be registered.

Every athlete must attach chips to his / her shoes – must see instructions bellow. Coaches are responsible for all chips issued to their team / school. There will be \$15 charge for every unreturned / damaged / lost chip. Every athlete must attach number with a bar code on the front of the uniform - please do not crumble it.

Number on the chip must match an athlete's bib number.

All High Schools will provide safety pins for their runners.

Bib Safety Pins

- ***All Schools will provide bib safety pins for their runners.(2012 NVAC Coaches mtg.rule)***

Timing Chips




- **Every high school athlete** will have assigned bib and **TWO (2) timing chips**.
- COMPETITOR'S NUMBERS AND CHIPS MUST BE ISSUED CORRECTLY ACCORDING TO THE TEAM ROSTER - INSIDE EVERY SCHOOL ENVELOP. ***Number on the chip(s) must match an athlete's bib number.***
- Every athlete must attach a chip to his / her shoe(s) - HS one for each shoe - using wire ties– must see instructions bellow. 4 wire ties (HS) per runner will be provided inside a school envelop.
- An athlete's shoe(s) is the only location for the chip.
- An athlete without chip(s) or a chip(s) attached at the different location than the shoe(s) will not be timed.
- Coaches are responsible for all chips issued to their team / school.
- ***Unused chips of non-participating athletes must be returned to the race finish before the race start.***
- Chips will be collected at the end of the finish chute.
- Athletes not finishing the race must bring their chips to the end the finish chute.
- There will be \$15.00 charge for every unreturned / lost / damaged chip.

Finish Line / Chute

- ***There will be no single file finish chute.***
- Finish line cameras may be used to assure the most accurate order of finish.
- ***Finish line will be the 1st edge of the 1st timing matt of the running diretion.***
- Finish chute will be approx. 15 feet (5 meters) wide and up to 100 feet (30 meters) long.
- An athlete must cross all blue timing matts (up to 4 matts) at the finish than proceed to the end of the finish chute where his / her chip will be collected.
- There is no need to stay in the finish order after crossing the timing matts.



How to attach the chip to a shoe

<p>Step 1</p> <p>Thread the wire ties under your shoe laces</p>	
<p>Step 2</p> <p>Thread the IPICO Sport Tag onto the wire ties</p>	
<p>Step 3</p> <p>Secure the IPICO Sport Tag by twisting the wires ties firmly together</p>
